

IRS Form W-8BEN Addendum

Statement of Permanent Residential Address

BFSFCU is required by the IRS to collect your Resident Tax Country information. The IRS Form W-8BEN indicates that *"...your permanent residence address is the country where you claim to be a resident for purposes of that country's income tax."*

Please declare your **resident tax country** in the statement below if your permanent residential address is:

- Within the U.S. and you are not a U.S. person for tax purposes; or
- Within a foreign country which is not your resident tax country

STATEMENT: For tax reporting purposes, I certify that _____ is my resident tax country and I do not have a permanent residential address in my resident tax country.

Statement of No Foreign Tax Identification Number

BFSFCU is required by the IRS to collect your Foreign Tax Identification Number (TIN) issued from your **resident tax country**. If your resident tax country does not issue TINs, the IRS Form W-8BEN indicates *"...you must provide the withholding agent [BFSFCU] with an explanation for why you have not been issued a TIN."*

You may provide an explanation for why you have not been issued a **TIN** by signing the statement below.

STATEMENT: For tax reporting purposes, I certify that:

- I have not been issued a TIN;
- My resident tax country does not issue TINs; or
- I am not legally required to obtain a TIN from my resident tax country
